

Pavilion Rental

Jefferson Patterson Park and Museum (JPPM), state museum of archaeology, interprets, preserves, studies, and exhibits for the public the diversity of cultures and environments of its property, the state of Maryland, and the Chesapeake Bay region.

The **Pavilion** is a beautiful 1940s cattle barn that has been renovated into a wonderful sheltered outdoor space. It is available for rent April through October, Wednesday to Sunday, between the hours of 10 am and 10 pm.

With 4,000 square feet under roof, the pavilion provides renters modern restrooms, an elevated stage, and a food service area with deep sinks, refrigerator/freezer and ice machine (cooking appliances are not available). Included in your rental is the use of 35 picnic tables, an open-air courtyard, and expansive lawn area. A waterfront ceremony site, non-picnic style tables, chairs, and other decorative elements are available for additional fees.

Please Note: The Pavilion is not available to rent for profit by private individuals or commercial concerns. Fees may not be charged for activities during an event without prior arrangement. Product may not be sold, except for educational or group discussion materials, and only with prior permission.

Jefferson Patterson Park and Museum (JPPM) is a 560-acre park and museum with 2.5 miles of waterfront along the Patuxent River and St. Leonard Creek in beautiful St. Leonard, Calvert County, Maryland.

Just a short drive off of Route 4, directions to JPPM are easy to follow:

From Points North

From Prince Frederick, follow Rt. 4 South for 3.8 miles. Turn right on Rt. 264, Broomes Island Road. Follow Rt. 264 for 2.2 miles, turning left on Rt. 265, Mackall Road. Follow for 5.6 miles, turning right into Park & Museum entrance.

From Points West

From Waldorf, follow Rt. 5 South to Hughesville. Take exit for Rt. 231 East, Prince Frederick Road. Follow for 12.3 miles to Prince Frederick. Follow directions above.

From Points South

From Lexington Park, follow Rt. 4 North for 13.8 miles. Turn left on Parran Road. Follow Parran Road to its end. Turn left onto Rt. 265, Mackall Road. Follow for 2.8 miles, turning right into Park & Museum entrance.

Base rental fees are dependent on the number of persons you plan to have in attendance. Rental hours included with the base fee are from 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM.

NOTE: The base fee is required by all renters regardless of the starting time of their event.
