## Fieldwork - Wednesdays, Fridays, and Saturdays

Includes excavating test units, screening soils for artifacts, and mapping remains associated with an 18<sup>th</sup>-century plantation on the Park grounds.



## Laboratory Work - Tuesdays and Thursdays

Includes cleaning and labeling artifacts, and preparing them for archival storage. Laboratory work takes place in the Maryland Archaeological Conservation Laboratory at JPPM.
