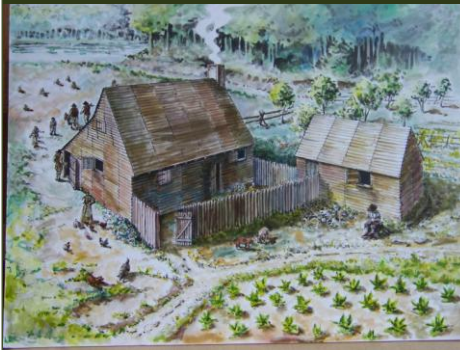

Plus campers will visit a colonial archaeological site to participate in a real excavation!

Discover what happens to artifacts when they enter the Maryland Archaeological Conservation Laboratory and our lab team goes to work.
